Blended Course Successfully Implemented Across Partner Organizations

Within the Leaders for Future project, an important milestone was reached with the successful implementation of the blended course for youth workers, mentors, and educators across partner organizations during February.

This 30-hour training programme combined online self-paced learning with interactive live sessions, creating a dynamic and flexible learning environment. Participants had the opportunity to both deepen their theoretical knowledge and engage in practical discussions, peer exchange, and real-life application of newly acquired skills.

Strengthening capacities to support young women

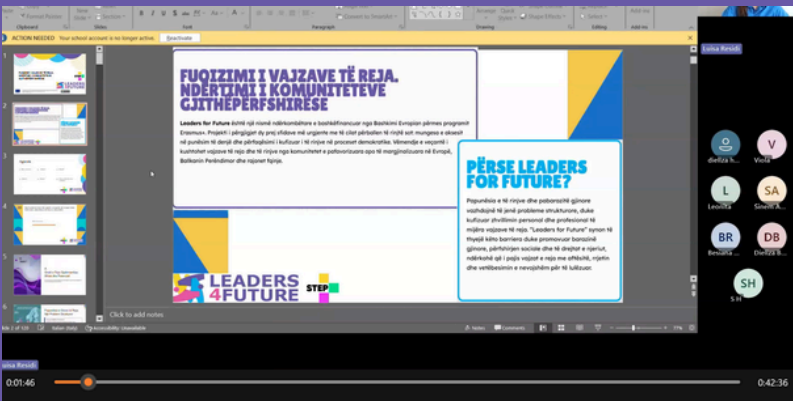
The course was specifically designed to address the needs of youth workers supporting young women in entrepreneurship. Particular attention was given to overcoming both structural and psychological barriers, such as limited access to resources, lack of confidence, and fear of failure.

Through the programme, participants explored advanced mentoring techniques, emotional intelligence, and gender-responsive approaches, gaining a deeper understanding of how to create more inclusive and supportive environments for young women.

From knowledge to practical tools

In addition to theoretical modules, the course introduced participants to a set of practical, ready-to-use resources developed within the project. These included tools and materials covering financial literacy, business planning, and digital brand development, all aligned with the **EntreComp** framework.

Participants tested these materials in practice, providing valuable insights into their usability and relevance. As part of the piloting phase, their feedback will directly contribute to further refinement and improvement of the training content



Building stronger support systems

By empowering youth workers with new knowledge, skills, and tools, the project is strengthening the wider ecosystem that supports young women in entrepreneurship. The course represents an important step towards creating more inclusive opportunities and enabling the next generation of women entrepreneurs and changemakers to develop and succeed.
